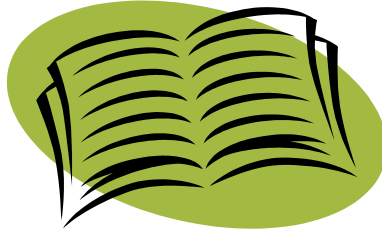


Storytown Reader Online Access



Dear Parents,

Great news! You can now access our reading book online! Students each have a user name and password that will allow them access to our readers from any computer with internet access.

To access the material, please go to: www.thinkcentral.com You will click on Reading and Language Arts. Next, click on Storytown. Be sure that the following information is listed on your computer:

State: Pennsylvania

District: Baldwin-Whitehall

School: Whitehall Elementary School

*Check the box to remember your organization. This will make logging in easier in the future.

User Name: 27lastnameinitial Example log in: 27walkerl

Password: bw123

Once logged in, you will want to access the "library." In the library, you will have access to all of the stories in our reading textbook. You also have access to the decodable books that correspond with our phonics skills. I think you'll find that this is a great resource, and it saves your child from having to bring home his or her reading for extra reading practice.

Please note that there are two sections, "My Test Scores" and "Things to Do" that will be blank. Because not everyone has access to the website, I will not be posting any mandatory assignments for your child to complete. This is simply a resource for you to use at home as you would like. It is particularly helpful when students need to read the story as part of their homework log. Students who access the Think Central website do not need to bring their books back and forth. If you plan to exclusively use the website, make sure your child knows so that he/she does not need to carry the reader back and forth.
